National Museum

The National Museum of Denmark in Copenhagen is Denmark's largest museum of cultural history, containing the histories of Danish and foreign cultures. The museum's main building is located a short distance from Strøget at the center of Copenhagen. It contains exhibits from around the world, from Greenland to South America.

Statens Museum for Kunst

The museum collects, registers, maintains, researches and handles Danish and foreign art dating from the 14th century to the present. The museum's collections constitute almost 9,000 paintings and sculptures, approximately 240,000 works of art on paper.

Tivoli Gardens


Tivoli Gardens is a famous amusement park and pleasure garden in Copenhagen, Denmark.
The park opened on 15 August 1843 and is the oldest operating amusement park in the world.
With 4.733 million visitors in 2015, Tivoli is the second-most popular seasonal theme park in the world.

Christianborg Palace

Christiansborg is a palace and government building in central Copenhagen, Denmark. It is the seat of the Danish Parliament, the Danish Prime Minister's Office and the Supreme Court of Denmark. Also, several parts of the palace are used by the Danish monarch, including the Royal Reception Rooms, the Palace Chapel and the Royal Stables.

Stretching from Kongens Nytorv to the harbor front just south of the Royal Playhouse, it is lined by brightly colored 17th and early 18th century townhouses and bars, cafes and restaurants. The canal harbors many historical wooden ships.
